# Identification and Registration Journey

- The evolution of identification systems in Somalia has been marked by gradual progress. Before and after independence, the country primarily relied on traditional paper methods. Key challenges, including poor infrastructure and a nomadic lifestyle, have historically constrained the uptake of identification.
- Despite these hurdles, the early years of independent Somalia saw a significant rise in identification and registration, particularly in urban centres, driven by increased literacy and expanded social services. The National ID system once linked crucial areas such as health, education, insurance, and housing.
- However, the civil war in 1991 devastated the existing identification framework, resulting in fragmented efforts to establish a cohesive identification system. These attempts fell short of fulfilling the need for a comprehensive National ID.
- Reconstituting the National Identification and Registration Authority (NIRA) has emerged as a vital catalyst for the government's transformation agenda, aiming to unify and modernize national identification.



### **Institutional Framework**

- Article 20(3) of the Somali Constitution guarantees citizens the right to obtain national identification documents, aligning with global standards under the Sustainable Development Goal 16.9.
- National ID Policies 2019
- The National Identification and Registration Law, passed in March 2023, provides a robust legal framework for identity registration and management
- The Data Protection law passed in March 2023,

# Multifaceted Benefits



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Accuracy of records: Currently UN agencies and NGOs register at household level which will put number SPP at 9.5 Million if all members in a family were registered (WFP report 2018)

Economic Inclusion (for instance, before the ID in India, 20% had the access to financial inclusion, after implementation of the ID, the 80% of the population get the access to financial inclusion).

In Somali case, only 5% of the population are estimated to have active bank accounts (UNIDO, 2020) where 80% of the Somali population lacks any proper/legal identification documents

# Multifaceted Benefits




Economic Growth (Digital ID is powerful key to inclusive growth, A 2019 McKinsey Global Institute report on digital inclusion found that widespread adoption of digital ID systems could unlock economic value equivalent to 3-13% of global GDP by 2030.

# SNID System Overview

### **Application Process**



### **Application Process**



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After approval, The system deduplicates the biographic data by comparing the completed applications in the data center. If it finds duplicate information it rejects automatically, if it is suspicious, an adjudication officers check and decide it.

### **ABIS**

The system deduplicates the biometrics by comparing the previous biometric data. If it finds duplicate it rejects automatically. If it resembles an adjudication officers decide by checking a certain threshold and the biographic data

### **Printing Credentials**

After deduplication, the NIN is generated National ID certificate is printed to complete the process for now.
Then the physical ID cards will be printed


### **Issue Credentials**

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The printed Certificates is delivered to the registration sites and issued to the applicants



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


### **Certificate Delivery System (CDS)**




